

CONNECTION COACH JOB DESCRIPTION

The goal of the Connection Coach is to meet the new Christian or new attendee where they are in their faith journey and assist them in connecting their desire to contribute their time and talent with the needs and opportunities at Parkview.

Time commitment

10-20-hours/ month (Varies per schedule, class size and number of coaches)

Qualifications

Potential Connection Coaches should exhibit the following:

- An active faith in Jesus.
- Able to clearly articulate and communicate faith journey.
- Wisdom, discernment, encouragement, and active listening skills.
- Competence with the various PCC ministries.
- Knowledge of PCC's culture.
- Availability to attend the Network class and spend time to follow up in person or on the phone with Network participants.

Training

Before assisting newcomers a Coach will receive training and visit or have first hand knowledge of PCC's primary ministries.

Responsibilities

The Connections Coach will assist:

- Participants of the Network Class upon completion of the class as they clarify and confirm their spiritual gifts, personal style and ministry passion. The Coach will help the Network Participant apply their knowledge to the ministry opportunities at Parkview that align with their goals. This may involve helping those who are currently serving identify if they are in the "best" area for their spiritual gifts and then helping them re-direct.
- The newcomer who requests assistance between scheduled Network Classes with the same criteria as above.
- The church staff in an ambassador's role in understanding the ministry goals and overall church philosophy.

The Connection Coach will follow-up with Network Participants and newcomers until that person connects to area of service or exits the serving process.
